The Armory Commission of Alabama wishes to solicit proposals from prospective Architects & Engineers (A&E) to provide implementation of the BUILDER Sustainment Management System (BUILDER) at several of our Army National Guard Facilities. The A&E must meet certain qualifications to submit a proposal and to be considered for this contract:

- At Least two (2) personnel shall have a current National Agency Check for Law and Credit (NACLC).
- At least one (1) person that will be on site must possess a Common Access Card (CAC).
