

Pursuant to Alabama Act No. 2001-956, the Armory Commission of Alabama is seeking qualified Architectural/Engineering (A/E) firms to provide professional consultant services for the implementation of Sustainment Management Systems BUILDER at various National Guard facilities throughout the state of Alabama and at Eglin Air Force Base, Florida.

Description: The scope of work involves the Implementation of Sustainment Management System BUILDER for Alabama Army National Guard Readiness Centers, Field Maintenance Sites, Consolidated Support Maintenance Sites, and Alabama Army National Guard Training Centers.

Typical work and budget estimation are as follows: Training of ALARNG Personnel, Selected Site facility condition assessments within the Sustainment Management System BUILDER, database input into BUILDER, and quality assurance/control for program management. The estimated budget for this project is \$400,000.00.

Qualification: A/E firms and all proposed consultants shall hold a professional license in the State of Alabama. A/E teams should be multi-disciplined and capable of completing facility condition assessments as required. A/E firms should have team members with appropriate Government Security Clearances, possess a Common Access Card for access to the Sustainment Management System BUILDER, and have qualified experience with BUILDER. Successful firms shall be capable of managing the implementation and training of Armory Commission designated technical staff members.

Application: The Armory Commission of Alabama utilizes a process similar to that outlined in the Manual of Procedures, prepared by the Alabama Building Commission, to appoint selection boards and evaluate the candidate firms. The selection board will provide a recommendation to the Armory Commission of the most qualified firms for this project.

Selection Criteria: Interested firms must submit a packet containing a letter of interest, completed Proposal Form and completed sections A, B, C, E, F, G and H of SF330. The Scope of Work (SOW), form of Proposal Letter, list of locations (by priority), solicitation letter, evaluation criteria and any Addenda issued may be found by clicking on the appropriate tab at: <http://al.ng.mil/ALABAMA/Pages/Public-Announcements.aspx>

This Selection Process is in accordance with Section 41-16-72(3), Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended.
NOTE: A/E firms **MUST** follow the Selection Criteria Format identified in order to be eligible for selection. Failure to follow this format may result in rejection of A/E firm's packet.

The Armory Commission may elect to allow up to four firms the opportunity to make a presentation to the Selection Board members. This presentation will take place at 1720 Congressman Dickinson Drive, Montgomery, Alabama 36109 on either 13, 14 or 15 September 2017. The presentation will last no longer than one hour.

Selection: The Selection Board will provide a recommendation to the Armory Commission of Alabama on selection of one A/E Firm for this work.
