Description: The scope of work involves providing design services (Type A, Type B and Type C) services for a National Guard Readiness Center. This facility will be constructed in accordance with the Congressionally Approved Project Scope, which has approximately 49,000 SQFT, and is currently programmed for a cost NTE \$13,683,000. The facility will include a Heating Plant, Geothermal, Metal Storage Building, privately owned parking, military parking, fire protection, utility services, storm drainage and detention / retention and other common supporting items (sidewalks, curbs, gutters, etc.) There are **NO COMMISSIONING SERVICES** to be conducted with this contract.

Qualification: Interested A&E Firms and all proposed consultants shall hold a professional license in the State of Alabama. A&E Firms teams should be multi-disciplined and capable of complete project design. Successful firms shall be capable of managing multiple projects simultaneously. All firms shall have a permanent office located within state of Alabama.

NOTE: Design and construction commissioning shall **NOT** be included in this contract.

Application: The Armory Commission of Alabama utilizes a process similar to that outlined in the Manual of Procedures, prepared by the Alabama Building Commission, to appoint selection boards and evaluate the candidate firms. The selection board will provide a recommendation to the Armory Commission of the most qualified firms for this project.
